Kindly be informed that the Directorate General of Health Services of the Ministry of Health and Family Welfare of Bangladesh has announced admission of foreign students in Government Medical and Dental Colleges for the academic year 2015-2016. This year total 203 seats are reserved for the foreign students, of which 102 seats are allocated for SAARC countries and 101 seats are allocated for non-SAARC countries. Country-wise allocation of seats is as follows:

02. In addition to admission in Government Medical Colleges, the Ministry of Health and Family Welfare will consider applications for admission in Private Medical Colleges in Bangladesh. List of Private Medical and Dental Colleges and availability of seats as received from the Directorate General of Health Services is enclosed at **Annexure A and B** respectively.
03. Criteria and procedure of application for foreign students in the said courses are enclosed at **Annexure C**. A prescribed application form is also attached.
04. **Deadlines for receiving applications at Bangladesh Missions abroad for admission are 05 November 2015 for Government Medical and Dental Colleges, and 20 November 2015 for Private Medical and Dental Colleges (No application will be considered after the deadline).** Duly filled in application forms with necessary academic documents should reach the Ministry of Foreign Affairs by **10 November 2015 and 25 November 2015 for Government and Private Medical Colleges respectively.** 03 (three) sets of photocopies of duly filled in application form, 03 (three) sets of photocopies of passport and telegraphic transfer/SWEFT must be enclosed with the original copy.
05. Process for application would remain the same as that of the last year (2014-2015). Applications with aggregate GPA less than 8.0 for Government Medical College and GPA less than 7.0 for Private Medical College will not be considered for admission. Hence, Missions are requested not to forward such applications to the Ministry. The merit list prepared by the Equivalence Committee in Bangladesh will be considered final. **(Application Form is available at: www.mofa.gov.bd).** Missions are requested to send the list of applicants (as the top sheet hard copy and soft copy) by fax/ e-mail in advance of the bag copy.
06. You are, therefore, requested to kindly disseminate the admission circular to concerned authorities (Ministry of Foreign Affairs/Ministry of Education/ other relevant organization) of your host country and countries of concurrent accreditation. You are also requested to kindly upload the circular at the Mission's website and arrange other modes of dissemination without involving cost.

The Ministry has further the honour to state that 89 seats in the Government MBBS Programme and 13 seats in the Government BDS Programme are reserved for the candidates from SAARC countries, while 79 seats in the Government MBBS Programme (05 seats allotted for Myanmar) and 22 seats in the Government BDS Programme are for the candidates from non-SAARC countries. Seats will be allocated on the basis of a combined merit list of interested and qualified candidates only.

In addition to admission in Government Medical Colleges, the Ministry of Health and Family Welfare will consider applications for admission in private Medical / Dental Colleges in Bangladesh. List of private Medical and Dental Colleges and availability of seats are enclosed herewith.

Criteria and procedure of application along with a prescribed application form are also attached. These are also available at: www.mofa.gov.bd.

The Ministry has further the honour to request the esteemed Missions in Dhaka to note that:

- Formats/process for application would remain the same as that of the previous year (2014-2015).
- MOFA will accept applications only through Bangladesh Missions abroad or through the the Embassies/ High Commissions in Bangladesh.
- Three (03) sets of photocopies of dully filled in application forms (along with enclosures) in addition to the original dully filled in application form (along with enclosures) need to be forwarded to Ministry of Foreign Affairs through appropriate diplomatic communication.
- The last date of receiving applications at the Ministry is **15 November 2015 for Government Medical and Dental Colleges and 25 November 2015 for private Medical and Dental Colleges. (No application will be considered after the deadline).**
- Applications not fulfilling the minimum GPA requirements will not be considered for admission.

Criteria for Admission of Foreign Students in the MBBS and BDS Courses in Government Medical Colleges / Dental Colleges / Units / Institutes in Bangladesh for 2015-2016 academic year under self-finance scheme.

A) Equivalence of Foreign Degree:

- Must have passed qualifying examinations (HSC/ 'A' level) or equivalent examination.
- SSC/ 'O' level or equivalent examination passed not before 2012.
- HSC/ 'A' level or equivalent examination passed not before 2014
- Minimum aggregate GPA in SSC / 'O' level or equivalent and HSC / 'A' level or equivalent examination : **8.00 (eight)**
- Minimum GPA in SSC / 'O' level or equivalent or in HSC / 'A' level and equivalent examination : 3.5
- Minimum GPA in Biology: 3.5
- For calculation of GPA against the marks obtained in SSC/ 'O' level or equivalent exam, only top 5 subjects are considered. Therefore, GPA in 'O' level = (total marks obtained in top five subjects)/5.
- For calculation of GPA against the marks obtained in HSC/ 'A' level or equivalent exam, only 3 subjects (Physics, Chemistry and Biology) are considered. Qualifying Grade in each subject individually is "C". Therefore, GPA in 'A' level = (total marks obtained in three subjects)/3.

B) Application Form: Duly filled in application forms in triplicate along with following documents, copy of passport and 6 passport size photographs are to reach the Mission by **05 November 2015** and the Ministry of Foreign Affairs by **10 November 2015**.

- All certificates must be duly attested by the competent authority, i.e. the Foreign Ministries of the respective countries and respective Bangladesh Missions abroad / respective Missions based in Dhaka.
- Successful applicants have to produce all academic certificates and mark-sheets / transcripts in original at the time of their admission.

C) Tuition Fees: For Government medical and dental colleges, students from SAARC countries will require to pay tuition and other fees at the rate charged to a Bangladeshi student. Students from other countries will have to pay \$5000 (five thousand) per academic year in addition to the tuition fees charged to a Bangladeshi student.

F) Equivalence of Foreign Degree:

- Must have passed qualifying examinations (HSC/ 'A' level) or equivalent examination.
- SSC/ 'O' level or equivalent examination passed not before 2012
- HSC/ 'A' level or equivalent examination passed not before 2014
- Minimum aggregate GPA in SSC / 'O' level or equivalent and HSC / 'A' level or equivalent examination: **7.00 (seven)**
- Minimum GPA in SSC / 'O' level or equivalent and in HSC / 'A' level or equivalent examination : 3.0
- Minimum GP in biology: 3.5
- For calculation of GPA against the marks obtained in SSC/ 'O' level or equivalent exam, only top 5 subjects are considered for calculation of GPA. Therefore, GPA in 'O' level = (total marks obtained in top five subjects)/5.
- For calculation of GPA against the marks obtained in HSC/ 'A' level or equivalent exam, only 3 subjects (Physics, Chemistry and Biology) are considered for calculation of GPA.
